**Special Conditions**

- 1.0 Applicant must comply with the requirements of all relevant regulations, by-laws and Municipal Code Chapters.
- 2.0 Please contact Municipal Licensing & Standards, to determine whether the event requires a Noise Exemption and monitoring by their By-law Officers. If a By-Law Officer is required, then payment must be made in advance of the event.
- 3.0 The tables must be placed in a manner to allow at least 2.13 m of clear sidewalk for safe, unobstructed pedestrian movement and must not obstruct any entrances/exits to buildings, fire connections or street furnishings such as news vending boxes, litter cans etc.
- 4.0 A minimum of 2.13 metres of unencumbered sidewalk is to be maintained and no merchandise is to be displayed where street furniture (ie. transit shelters, planters, news vending boxes, Info Pillars, etc) would leave less than 2.13 metres of clear sidewalk.
- 5.0 Any cables crossing over City street allowance must be covered with a levelled plank for pedestrian safety
- 6.0 Any outdoor food preparation must be done by licensed food premises that prepare food and this preparation must be done in front of their premises and in accordance with Toronto Public Health regulations.
- 7.0 Appropriate visions splays must be maintained at intersections and adjacent to driveways and lanes.
- 8.0 Curbside display of merchandise or defacement of the City sidewalk in any manner (including the use of water soluble paints) is not permitted.

I/We hereby agree and bind myself/ourselves my/our heirs, executors, administrators, successors, or assigns to indemnify fully and save harmless the City of Toronto, or its officers, agents, officials, employees or workers from any and all actions, claims, demands, damage, loss or expense whatsoever, arising from or incidental to the issuing of this permit, the occupation of any part of the street hereunder, or the erection, continuance, want of repair or inadequacy in any respect whatsoever of any structure or thing erected, and agree to abide by all of the conditions listed on this permit.
